

# Membership Guidelines

## Application Requirements

- Student must be homeschooled. 51% of the homeschooling must be supervised by the parent.
- Applications may be submitted at the end of the spring semester of the student's 8<sup>th</sup> grade year through October of his/her 12<sup>th</sup> grade year, for membership during 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grades.
- Applicant must have a 3.5 grade point average on a 4-point scale and must supply a transcript with his/her application.
- Applicant must provide proof of test scores from one of the following tests: Stanford, IOWA, Terra Nova 2 (CAT 6) 2<sup>nd</sup> Ed. (90% composite score), SAT (1200), ACT (26), PSAT (1200), PSAT 10 (1170), PSAT 8/9 (1090 for grade 9 or 1020 for grade 8) or CLT (88). Parent may NOT administer the test or be present during the test/on-line test.
- Applicant must submit a short statement about why he/she would like to be a member of the National Homeschool Honor Society.
- Applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from an adult who can attest to applicant's academic performance and/or strength of character.
- Applicant must submit a list of three additional names and addresses of individuals who would be willing to provide a recommendation on your behalf.
